Titled *Dream Time*, the book is now in its second printing.

Neville told the Reporter, "In the pursuit of happiness, one must follow one's passions in life . . . travel the distance and share your dreams."

Catherine too has led an interesting life. Born in Ireland, she migrated to the U.S.A. as a nanny.
